## OBJECTIVE FOR EX - POST EVALUATION OF IPARD PROGRAMME 2007- 2013

- > The degree of utilisation of resources;
- The effectiveness and efficiency of the IPARD Programme;
- Its socioeconomic impact and
- ➤ Its impact on the defined priorities.







#### PURPOSE OF EX-POST EVALUATION



- Progress made by the IPARD Programme (goals, output, result and impact);
- Improve the quality (effectiveness) of the RD programming;
- Identify the factors contributing to success or failure of the Programme implementation,
- The sustainability of actions and identifications of best practices;
- To provide lessons learned for designing future programmes.







#### REALIZATION OF EX-POST EVALUATION



- Contract IPARDMA/03/2018 signed 06.06.2019;
- ➤ Final Report approved 23.09.2020;
- Ex post evaluation of IPARD Programme 2007-2013 payed 21.10.2020.







#### FINAL REPORT / RECOMMENDATIONS

- ➢ IPARD Agency and MA should explore ways to speed timeline between application and fund disbursement; (long timeline);
- MA and the IPARD Agency to focus on regions with poor uptake and better support application proposals; (poor geographical coverage);
- Improve communication between applicants and the IPARD Agency (Inefficient communication channels);
- Introducing software solutions (receiving / evaluating / payment) and interconnectivity between databases;









#### FINAL REPORT / RECOMMENDATIONS

- More focused calls; (E.g investments that would be directly linked to food safety, animal welfare or for environment;
- Improving the quality of advisory service (The quality of the advice given is reported as very varied in quality);
- Pre-financing support Access to credit and financial instruments, loan guarantee fund etc. (A major constraint to the increased uptake of the programme by many smaller farming applicants is the access to credit, or counterpart funds from own resources);







#### FINAL REPORT / RECOMMENDATIONS

Efficiency of the IPARD 2007-2013 institutional framework (The inst. framework could not be considered efficient during the implementation of IPARD Programme 2007-2013);

To develop medium - and long-term recruitment/retention policy in the IPARD structures (Fast turnover of officials, with negative consequences to institutional capacity);

The accreditation of the additional measures (Measures under Axis 2 and LEADER are not accredited);

Avoid deadweight (in the design of the eligibility criteria, the objectives of the measures, and in the definition of eligible investments).
